1. The Government of Tamil Nadu through Government of India has applied for financing from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of Chennai Kanyakumari Industrial Corridor Project. Part of this financing will be used for payments under the Contracts named above. Bidding is open to eligible Bidders from eligible source countries of ADB. Bidders may bid for one or several contracts, as further defined in the bidding document. Bidders wishing to offer discounts in case they are awarded more than one contract will be allowed to do so provided those discounts are included in the Letter of Financial Bid.
2. The Chennai Kanyakumari Industrial Corridor Project, Highways and Minor Ports Department ("the Employer") for and on behalf of the Governor of State of Tamil Nadu invites sealed bids from eligible Bidders for the construction, maintenance and completion of "Upgrading Cuddalore–Madapattu Section of SH 09 (Km 3+000 to Km 41+910) from km 3+000 to 21+100 and Km 28+500 to 41+910 to two lane with paved shoulders and construction of a bypass to Panruti town for a length of 5.850 km length from km 22+650 to 28+500 and maintenance of entire project stretch of 37.36 km for 7 years" (in the State of Tamil Nadu on Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) Mode) ("the Works").
3. Open competitive bidding will be conducted in accordance with ADB's "Single-Stage: Two-Envelope" procedure and is open to all Bidders from eligible countries as described in the Bidding Document. The Bidder shall have
  - the nationality of an eligible country approved by ADB
  - Minimum average annual construction turn over of INR 199,00,00,000 calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed within last 5 years.
  - Participation in atleast one contract with a value of at INR 172 Crore only (INR One Hundred and Seventy Two Crores Only) or two contracts with a value of at least INR 129 Crore only (INR One hundred and Twenty Nine Crore only) in each contract within last 5 years.
