Assignment title: Consultancy services to assist in Implementation of Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Plan under **CKICP**

Reference: TN/CKICP/LAIC/2018-1, Dated 22 /04/2018

Government of Tamil Nadu (GoTN) is implementing the Chennai – Kanyakumari Industrial Corridor Project (CKICP) that aims at improving 15 State Highways to a length of about 655km utilizing the loan assistance from Asian Development Bank (ADB). Project involves acquisition of land across 19 districts which involves rehabilitation and resettlement of Project Affected Persons (PAPs).

Chennai – Kanyakumari Industrial Corridor Project (CKICP) proposes to appoint 4 consultants/ NGOs experienced in carrying out such Rehabilitation and Resettlement (R&R) activities at the grass root level to assist the Project Implementation Unit (PIU) in Resettlement Plan (RP) implementation. The scope of the consultancy services is to 1) Assist PIU, Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Unit (LARRU) of CKICP in effective implementation of RP 2) Disseminate project impacts and information on Entitlement Matrix (R&R Policy) 3) Support in identifying the resettlement sites, in compensations and relocation of affected community's assets 4) Establishment and Maintenance of a Computerized Management Information System (CMIS) with details of all information related to RP and 5) Support PAPs in getting their benefits including assistance in opening bank account, attending the queries/clarifications raised by the bank or Income Tax department with respect to the compensation of LARR.

The consultancy contract period is expected to span for a period of about 24 months. The GoTN through the Project Director, CKICP now invites eligible Consultants to express their interest in providing the Services. Interested firms should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The short listing criteria will be: 1) Experience in implementing similar LARR works under the World Bank, ADB, JICA loan assisted projects, 2) Experience in RP implementation in Tamil Nadu will be given additional preference and 3) Consultant should have implemented at least 3 similar projects

Consultants should provide information such as their roles in executing the above services (whether a sole provider or a partner in a joint venture) and provide details of scope of services of each assignment to demonstrate suitability for present assignment. The consultant should provide details on statement of related

assignments completed in the last 10 years, supported with completion certificate of the Employer of the services.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.10 of the Asian Development Bank's Guidelines: "Guidelines on The Use of Consultants by Asian Development Bank and Its Borrowers, March 2013 ("Consultant Guidelines)", setting forth the policy on conflict of interest.

Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications. Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based System (QCBS) set out in the Consultant Guidelines by ADB. If the consultants intend to apply for multiple packages, they should undertake to propose different teams in the EOI of the respective packages.
